Hearts filled with gratitude

Wherever we go and in whatever we do, we always have a choice to make. We can choose to approach any situation with a grateful heart, or not. I would wager to say that those who do approach life's moments with a cheerful heart tend to be happier people. At Good News Project, I encounter people who are grateful every day. It may be a volunteer who is thankful to be serving and finds wholeness as a human being by giving of their time and talent. It may be a person on the edge of poverty or despair who just experienced a kind helping hand.

Just this week my co-worker Toni completed a HELP closet transaction with a hug. When she relayed the story to me just minutes later, she told me the client she helped was completely stressed with the rapid decline of her mother. When the client entered our doors she anticipated one more stress to pile up on her shoulders. Toni gently helped her find the right wheelchair and told her to take it out the door and make sure it worked for her mom. No contract, no paperwork...just

go make sure it works. The woman was taken aback when Toni told the client she trusted her to come back and make sure the paperwork was complete if the wheelchair did meet the need. Toni sealed the offer with a hug. Now, we don't do HELP closet transactions like this every day but we do have a spoken rule in our office which says "there are always exceptions to the rule". The woman did come back that very afternoon and we completed the transaction. I couldn't help but be grateful for Toni at that moment following her heart instead of her head. I could see the relief spread across the client's face and it was rewarding to see her later that afternoon a little less frantic and a bit more whole.

In August 2015, Tropical Storm Erika hit Dominica and not only wiped out over 200 homes, but killed many people, washed away farms, roads and animals and made the airport inoperable for 3 months. In response Good News Project mobilized an additional team of volunteers in January to build four homes in the area (instead

of two) and the locals were sincerely grateful that we responded in this way. We worked hand in hand with our local Dominican committee to bring hope to our neighbors. Those who received a new home were grateful. Our volunteers were grateful to have had the opportunity.

We are presented daily with moments in which to be both great and grateful. The question is, will we embrace those moments?

Our **HELP closet** has a fresh new look and a broad selection of durable medical equipment. We have trained a few volunteers to help with filing, sanitizing and maintaining inventory. We also have the perfect person to help us with minor repairs on our equipment. In 2015 we assisted an average of 65 customers per month and handled 1032 pieces of equipment in one year! A bright new window and countertop were installed in the space to make the HELP closet more welcoming to clients.

If you know a neighbor, family member or friend in need of gently used durable medical equipment, send them over to Good News Project. Our staff and volunteers serve clients with compassion and knowledge. We are looking to recruit volunteers specifically for dropping off and picking up items.



Our **e-cycling program** continues to be an impressive weekly generator of income for Good News Project. All proceeds are undesignated and can go wherever we need them. Commodity prices were a bit lower in 2015 than in previous years but the program continues to provide revenue, good will in the community, and the peace of mind that your electronics are responsibly recycled. Good News Project maintains certification with the state of Wisconsin and stays current on new trends and state policies that may affect our organization or our consumers.

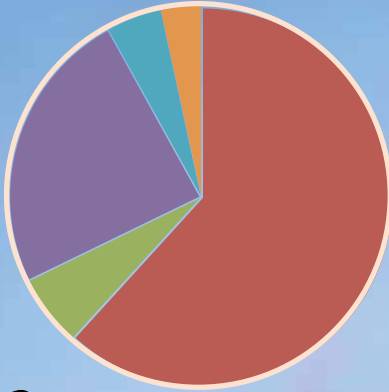

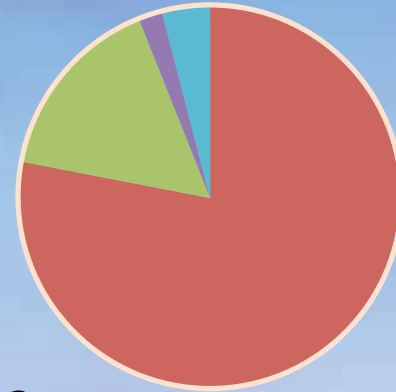

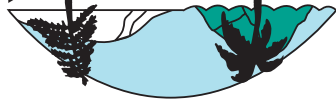
