
3 in 1 commode

A commode offers more accessibility and safety with toileting. A standard commode offers the ability to be used at the bedside to avoid long distances for toileting. Most commodes can also double as a raised toilet seat or toilet safety frame when placed over your existing toilet. They are made of aluminum or steel, and are height adjustable to allow improved ease with sitting to standing during the toileting process. The measured base of a commode is about 24" across and 18" deep.

Adjusting Commode Height

1. Depress the height adjustment button and

slide the lower leg upward or downward until the height adjustment button clicks into place in the desired hole.

2. Repeat for other 3 legs.

WARNING: Ensure that all four commode legs are adjusted to the same height, and that all height adjustment buttons protrude fully through adjustment holes before use.
